

Stock PE Sell – Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

1. When should I procure the algo?

Before expiry week of this month for the next month, to avoid delays, queues and ensure readiness.

2. When should I start the algo?

As soon as the option video is released and trading details are shared you can launch your choice of stock

3. Can I choose any stock?

No. The algo only supports stocks featured in the official video.

4. Can I change my Max Exposure?

Yes, but only between 10 AM–4:30 PM. Stop the algo, change the Max Exposure and restart with same data. However if you are in paper trade mode you can change any data any time

5. Can I terminate the algo mid-session?

Yes. All trades and open position must be managed manually thereafter. You should not restart the algo if you have manually changed in dmat account or there is a delay of more than 15 minutes

6. What if the server has power or internet failure?

The server has power backup. On internet failure, the algo will wait and resume. In case of a crash, it will restart with back up data which is saved every 5 minutes. Such events will qualify under force majeure and there could be losses which are not claimable.

7. Can I try papertrade before live trading?

Yes. Best way would be to Start with *papertrade = 0*. Once a trade is taken you can stop the Algo, switch to *papertrade = 1*, and restart quickly to catch the trade. If you think you may not be in position to know the live position or will be inaccessible, it will be safe to start with *papertrade = 1*. Remember paper trade =1 will result into real trade and profit or loss. Please consult your financial advisor.

8. What happens if I use papertrade the whole month?

You will have insight how the algo works and the nuances of the market. There would be no actual profit or loss, however the Algo will show paper profit/loss. The link will be credited automatically for the next month.

9. What if I selected real trade mode but no trade was executed?

If the Master Algo finds no suitable trade opportunity existed throughout the month, the link will be credited for next month. The Channel's decision on this will be final and binding and no claim will be entertained
